THE REGULATIONS

In the main the regulations for the 2017 CBA Africa Concours d'Elegance do not contain any major changes.

To recognize the hard work involved in preparing a car, or motorcycle there will be a minimum of three prizes in each of the nineteen classes.

Once again the entry fees remain unchanged because of the harsh economic conditions affecting all of us. The normal entry fee is 3500 shillings per vehicle and competitors with more than one machine will pay a fee of 3000 shillings for each of the additional entries.

Arrangements are underway for the regulations to be printed and they will soon be available on the event website.

Meanwhile we are attaching to this bulletin a provisional list of the classes and an entry form.



THE TV PREMIERE AND OFFICIAL LAUNCH OF THE REGULATIONS

It is hoped to hold the Premiere of the 2016 CBA Africa Concours d'Elegance TV programme and the official launch of the regulations for this year's event during the last week of February.

At this function there will be a draw for three cash prizes of 20,000 shillings each for competitors who have submitted paid entries.
