## **1927 DODGE**

Magdi Riad has entered a rare 1927 Dodge saloon which will contest the Pre 1940 Car Class in the Concours d'Elegance. At present this is the oldest car on the entry list and Ted Wanday's 1956 BSA is the oldest motorcycle.



The 1968 Alfa Romeo 1750 Spider of Alec Davis will be a star attraction in the Sports Car Class. Claudio Tosoni, the former owner, was the overall winner of the 1997 Concours with this Alfa. Car entries range in size from the 1972 Austin Mini entered by Vitafoam Products Limited to the large 1991 Mercedes Benz of Dr. Joseph Aluoch and Magdi Riad's 1952 Chevrolet Deluxe. Maina Muthuma will return to the Nairobi racecourse with his 1960 Morris Minor and Samuel Mwai will be showing a 1997 Peugeot 504.

In addition to the massive street and trail bikes entered by twelve members of the Uganda Bikers Association a classic 1957 BSA will be shown by Stephen Tabaruka who will bring his machine from Kampala to Nairobi.

# LET'S GO TO KAMPALA

Leslie Carvell will be driving her 1970 VW Beetle from Jinja to compete in the Concours d'Elegance and Tor Allan will be motoring to Nairobi from Arusha in his 1966 Peugeot 404. Last year there were five car entries from Uganda in the Concours.



Let's take our turn to travel to Kampala for the Uganda Vintage and Classic Auto Show (a Concours event) scheduled for Saturday July 29<sup>th</sup> in the grounds of the Kampala Sheraton Hotel. Two years ago Peter Wanday took his 1972 Alfa Romeo 2000GTV by road from Nairobi with an overnight stop in Eldoret. Last year Daniel Biwot drove his 1985 Mercedes from Nairobi to Kampala in one day.
