FORTY EIGHT AND SEVEN

The 2018 CBA Africa Concours d'Elegance scheduled for September 30th at the Nairobi Racecourse will be the forty eighth in the annual series organised by the Alfa Romeo Owners Club and the seventh to be sponsored by CBA.

It is hoped that the event will prove to be a great celebration of classic and vintage cars and motorcycles for the East and Central African region.



THE REGULATIONS

The regulations for the Concours have been approved for cars by the Kenya Motorsports Federation Limited and for motorcycles by the Kenya Motorsports Foundation. The event has been recognized and sanctioned by FIM Africa and has continental status for cars and bikes.

Recognising the harsh economic conditions which we are all facing the entry fees have been kept the same as last year.

The regulations are already available from the event website www.concourskenya.com and printed copies will be ready soon.

In a move to start bringing the Concours in line with other events around the world car entries have been limited to vehicles made in 2003, or earlier. It is worth noting that if this regulation had been applied last year no competitor would have been excluded from the event.

There has been no change in the age requirements for motorcycles which remains machines made three years ago, or earlier.

For many years there has been a class for cars made in 1940, or earlier. This places all the “Golden oldies” together for judging.

To treat motorcycles in a similar way there will be a class for bikes made in 1960, or earlier.

It is hoped to hold the official launch of the CBA Africa Concours d'Elegance and the premiere of the TV programme during the first week of March at the Panafric hotel.
