transform a small event held in the grounds of the Spread Eagle Hotel (Now the Safari Park) into an Africa status Concours d'Elegance. This draws a crowd of 10,000 to the stately grounds of the Nairobi Racecourse on the last Sunday of September each year which has become a diary date for classic and vintage car and motorcycle enthusiasts and socialites.

We are extremely grateful to everybody who has contributed to the growth of the Concours over the years.

TAKE OFF

The 2020 Concours d'Elegance is scheduled for September 27th and the preparations have already taken off.

The regulations for both cars and motorcycles have been published on the Concours website

The entry list has been opened and competitors are welcome to register soon.

THE REGULATIONS

In the main the regulations follow the pattern of those of previous years. The only significant change is competing cars must have been made in 1995, or earlier. Motorcycles that are five or more years old are eligible to compete.

Recognising the current harsh economic conditions there have been no changes to the entry fee of Ksh 4,000 for a single vehicle. Competitors entering more than one vehicle will pay a fee of Ksh 3,000 for each of the additional entries.

The next bulletin will be issued towards the end of January and will communicate the arrangements and date for the official launch of the regulations for 2020 and the premiere of the Concours television programme.
