MOVING FORWARD

The Alfa Romeo Owners club and the organisers of the forthcoming 50th anniversary Africa Concours d'Elegance are moving forward with the preparations.

The regulations have been approved by the Kenya Motor Sports Federation for cars and the Kenya Motorcycle Sports Foundation for bikes and they are available on the event website (www.concourskenya.com).

To ensure high standards of judging the field will be limited to 70 cars and 40 motorcycles. There will be an impressive number of prizes including the top three cars and bikes, class winners and the best results achieved by machines of various makes.

For easy reference we are attaching the provisional list of twelve classes for cars and eight for motorcycles. As stated in the regulations the classes might be altered depending on entries received towards the closing date.

PLAN AHEAD

We recommend that competitors plan ahead and submit entries in good time. Paid entries for the 2020 and 2021 events remain valid. Meanwhile the entry list continues to grow. The latest is Gary Farrant's 1972 Volvo coupe which will be listed in the appropriate touring car class.

FIA Founding Members Heritage Cup

As some Concours competitors and officials are unaware of the objective and status of the FIA Founding Members Heritage Cup we are including a summary in this bulletin.

Each year the FIA recognises an outstanding contribution to the classic and vintage car movement by awarding the Founding Members Heritage Cup.

For 2021 the Kenya Motor Sport Federation (KMSF) proposed Bob Dewar the Director of the Africa Concours d'Elegance and the event.

After the judging ended the FIA declared, "Bob Dewar nominated by the Kenya Motor Sport Federation was awarded the FIA Founding Members Heritage Cup."

This is a boost for Kenya by becoming the first African country to earn the coveted trophy.
