## **The Classic Car and Motorcycle Sale**

### ***At The 2022 Africa Concours d'Elegance***

## **Introduction**

For the past 26 years the Classic Car and Motorcycle Sales have been held at the annual Africa Concours d'Elegance. This is a good opportunity for the owners of unwanted classics (made in 1997, or earlier) to offer them for sale to the enthusiasts who gather at the Nairobi Racecourse for the classiest event on the motorsport calendar.

A significant number of spectators at the Racecourse are interested in buying a classic for preparation for a future Concours, or for use as a weekend fun car, or motorcycle.

Although the Sale will be held at the Nairobi Racecourse on the same day as the Concours d'Elegance, it will be a completely separate event.

## **Regulations for the Classic Car and Motorcycle Sale**

### ***Eligibility***

Any car, or motorcycle made **in 1997, or earlier**, regardless of the machine's condition.

### ***Entries***

The number of entries shall be limited to the **first 30** received by the Secretary.

Entries will be accepted forthwith and up to noon on Wednesday September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

**The entry fee is Kshs. 2,000 per vehicle.**

The Secretary of the Classic Car and Motorcycle Sale is Hellen Andrew and entries should be submitted to her at the Bob Dewar Publicity offices on the second floor of Block G, Norfolk Towers, Kijabe Street. ## *Administration*

Prior to the event, entrants will receive a bulletin allocating their parking bays. A sticker for each vehicle on sale and two complimentary admission tickets for ***The 2022 Africa Concours d'Elegance*** will be enclosed with the bulletin.

Owing to the limited access to the competitors paddock, trade stands and the Classic Car and Motorcycle Sale area and space limitations, it is regretted that each classic car and motorcycle entrant will be limited to one vehicle pass.

The Classic Car and Motorcycle Sale will be held at the Nairobi Racecourse, Ngong Road, starting at 10.00 a.m. on Sunday September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

All entrants of vehicles must register with the Secretary by 9.00 a.m. which is the time the Racecourse gates open to the public on Sunday September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

## *Willing Buyer/Willing Seller*

Each owner of a vehicle offered for sale will be solely responsible for selling his, or her machine and transferring the ownership to the purchaser. Transactions will be carried out on a ***willing buyer/willing seller*** basis.

The Alfa Romeo Owners Club and the Jockey Club of Kenya will have no involvement in, or responsibility for any transactions carried out at the Nairobi Racecourse on Sunday, September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022, or after that date.

## *Consumption of Alcohol*

Alcoholic drinks must not be brought into the Classic Sale, the competitors paddock and the motorcycle judging ring. Participants in the Classic Sale are not allowed to drink alcohol in these areas.

## *Responsible behaviour*

While in the Nairobi Racecourse grounds participants in the Classic Sale are expected to behave responsibly. Any dangerous driving, or bad behaviour will result in banning from future Concours events.
