REGULATIONS

Introduction

The Motor Clubs Arcade has proved to be a popular showcase for motor clubs at the Africa Concours d'Elegance. Consequently, the Alfa Romeo Owners Club has decided to continue to give all motor sport commissions of Kenya Motor Sports Federation (KMSF) and Motorcycle Sports Federation of Kenya (MSFK) as well as formal motor clubs the opportunity to use the classiest event on the motor sport calendar to promote their activities.

Arrangements have been made for a line of motor club exhibits running parallel to the Auto Expo (the motor trade stands at the Concours). This will create an area titled "The Motor Clubs Arcade" and the Concours organizers hope that club exhibits will boost motor sport in Kenya.

Regulations

Summary

The Motor Clubs Arcade will be an informal exposition and the rules have been kept to a minimum.

Eligibility

The Motor Clubs Arcade is open to motor sport commissions of KMSF and MSFK as well as formal motor clubs.

Exhibition space

Each exhibitor will be allocated a plot with a minimum size of eight metres by five metres. The space will be adequate for a tent and a **maximum of three cars**. Alternatively the plot can be filled with buggies, karts, or motorcycles.

Allocation of plots

Plots will be allocated on a first come first served basis starting with the best location and continuing down the line running parallel to the Motor Trade stands.

Entries

There will be an entry fee of Ten Thousand Shillings (KShs. 10,000) per club for the plots in the Motor Clubs Arcade except for motorsports clubs affiliated to the Kenya Motor Sports Federation (KMSF) and Motorcycle Sports Federation of Kenya (MSFK) whose affiliation is up to-date and in good standing who will have this fee waived. The final deadline for entries will be noon on Wednesday September 17th 2025 provided there is space.

Motor Clubs Arcade briefing Tuesday September 23rd, 2025 at 2.30 p.m.

There will be a mandatory briefing meeting for participants in the Motor Clubs Arcade on Tuesday September 23rd at 2.30 p.m. at the Nairobi Racecourse.

The organizers of the event will explain the location and dimensions of each plot, issue complimentary tickets, explain the rules for exhibitors and answer questions.

Outline of the Motor Clubs Arcade Rules

IN THE INTEREST OF EXHIBITORS, SPECTATORS AND ORGANISERS, PLEASE FOLLOW THE LETTER AND SPIRIT OF THESE RULES. ENTRIES FOR FUTURE EVENTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FROM A PARTICIPANT WHO INFRINGES THESE RULES.

1. Stand structures and exhibits must be contained within the boundaries of each plot. Portable displays, banners, flags must not appear outside exhibitors' stand.
2. Exhibitors are not allowed to distribute leaflets etc. outside their plots but may do so within the confines of their plots.
3. As the Motor Clubs Arcade organizers are unable to arrange for the supply of electricity, exhibitors requiring electricity should bring their own portable generators. To avoid interfering with other exhibitors and the public address system please use a quiet running generator placed at the rear of the stand.
4. The Nairobi Racecourse will be open for stand building between 9.00a.m. and 6.00 p.m. from Wednesday, September 24th, 2025.

Exhibitors stands must be ready by 6.00 p.m. on Saturday, September 27th, 2025.

- 5 To limit damage to the Nairobi Racecourse grounds, exhibitors are asked to minimize the use of vehicles and ensure that they are driven carefully and slowly during the preparations, the event on Sunday, September 28th and the clearing process on Monday September 29th, 2025.
6. The gates of the Nairobi Racecourse open to the public at 9.00 a.m. on Sunday, September 28th, 2025 and exhibitors are requested to clear their stands of construction materials, service

vehicles etc. in good time. Service and display vehicles will not be allowed to enter the grounds after 9.00 a.m. on September 28th, 2025.

7. The entrance road to the Motor Clubs Arcade is shared by Auto Expo, Concours competitors and their support cars, participants in the Classic Car and Motorcycle Sale and members of the Alfa Romeo Owners Club. Accordingly exhibitors are requested to ensure they bring all items they require before the Racecourse gates open to the public at 9.00 a.m. on September 28th, 2025. It will be very difficult to leave the Racecourse to collect forgotten items between 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. on the day of the Concours.
8. The Africa Concours d'Elegance is an FIM-AFRICA recognized and sanctioned event which has stringent fire protection rules.
Accordingly each exhibitor must have at least one fire extinguisher.
To ensure compliance with this requirement Concours officials will carry out a check of each stand on Saturday September 27th at 12:00 noon and again on Sunday September 28th at 9:00am.
9. Catering and drinks services will be available at convenient points in the Nairobi Racecourse grounds. Accordingly, exhibitors are not allowed to prepare, or sell food, or drink of any kind.
10. The efficient running of the Concours d'Elegance will depend to a great extent on public address announcements. For this reason exhibitors are asked not to use music systems, or loudspeakers on their stands.
11. Owing to the limited space available at the Nairobi Racecourse and the likelihood of dusty conditions, **exhibitors are not permitted to demonstrate cars and motorcycles at the Nairobi Racecourse during Concours day.**
12. Each exhibitor will receive six complimentary passes for personnel on duty. This means the exhibitor taking up a stand, and not per individual car displayed in the stand.
13. Exhibitors requiring additional guest tickets should purchase these in advance at the event's ticketing portal.

14. **Exhibitors must dismantle their stands and clear their plots by noon on Monday September 29th, 2025.**
15. The organizers of the event will have security guards on duty from Tuesday, September 23rd 2025 until noon on Monday, September 29th 2025 but participants in the Motor Clubs Arcade are solely responsible for the security of their exhibits and staff and are free to bring their own additional security should they require. Neither the Alfa Romeo Owners Club, nor the Jockey Club of Kenya accepts any responsibility for the security of exhibitors.
16. It is hoped that these rules and regulations are adequate for the Motor Clubs Arcade but the organizers reserve the right to issue additional rules and regulations at their own discretion.
